Congregational Meeting August 22...

There will be congregational meetings on August 22 after both the outdoor and indoor worship services. Among other agenda items, the Council is seeking approval to switch our online streaming platform from Zoom to YouTube. Specifically, we want to have a dedicated YouTube Channel that members and the public can access. Zoom has served us well, but in addition to the yearly subscription fee and the cumbersome access process, we've been limited in production quality and the scope of what we can do with our broadcast. YouTube is free. Worship services are automatically recorded and can be accessed throughout the week on our own YouTube channel. We have control of the videos and can delete them whenever we want. The link to our channel will not change, and we can put it on our website for ease of access. A viewer can also do a quick YouTube search for it. You can watch the streaming service or a taped service on your computer or phone. Many smart TVs and streaming devices such as Roku and Xfinity Flex have the YouTube channel on them, so you can watch the service right on your TV in high-definition quality. A question-and-answer session will be followed by a vote. Thank you for considering this item in advance of the meeting.
