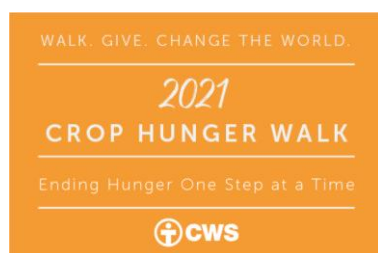

This year’s Crop Walk is today. The Crop Walk is a community-led fundraising event to end hunger. The Jefferson Area Crop Walk is one of the oldest at 34 years. 25% of the money collected stays in the area to help out our local food pantries. AED Equipped Facility...



We now have an automated external defibrillator (AED) located in the south vestibule of our church. AEDs are portable, life-saving devices designed to treat people experiencing sudden cardiac arrest, a medical condition in which the heart stops beating suddenly and unexpectedly. Although we hope never to have to use it, the Council felt it was important to equip our church with this important life-saving device. The AED was purchased using money from the memorial fund.

Carillon to be installed soon...

The speaker cables have been put into place by Miller Electric and now we are just awaiting the Verdin technician to come in and install the carillon system. The carillon and all associated costs have been donated to the church by the Allan Hoke family.
