*Call to Worship (Based on: On Pentecost They Gathered NCH):*

L: When the day of Pentecost arrived, the disciples gathered in one place to worship and to pray.

**P: And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a wind and tongues of fire inspired each person!**

**ALL Sing: The people all around them were startled and amazed to understand their language, as God in Christ they praised. What universal message, what great good news was here? The Christ, once dead, is risen to vanquish all our fear. (Stanza 2 - #272 NCH)**

L: God poured out the Holy Spirit on all who would believe that day, on women and men, and children who would receive God's grace, bestowing them with power and life.

**P: And that day three thousand people welcomed this message, were baptized and the church was formed! Come Holy Spirit, come!**

**ALL Sing: O Spirit, sent from heaven on that day long ago, rekindle faith among us in all life's ebb and flow. O give us hearts to listen and tongues aflame with praise, so folk of every nation glad songs of joy shall raise. (Stanza 4 - #272 NCH)**

L: God of grace, send upon us today your Holy Spirit as you sent the Spirit upon the apostles on the day of Pentecost, so that our prayers and our deeds may bear witness to your desire for us:

**ALL: We wish to be one, Lord, so that the world may believe that we belong to you. Spirit of fire, inflame us with Christ's love.**
